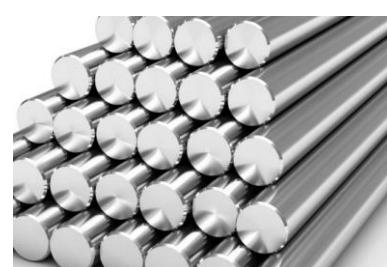
About conference
